About Coastal Racing

Our Coastal racing series comprises 4 days where yachts race set courses around Carlisle Bay, the South Coast and West Coast. The course marks are large orange tetrahedrons and the yachts must round these marks without hitting them. Handicaps are applied to each competing yacht, so it's not always the first across the finish line that wins.

Yachts race in 5 different classes each flying a different coloured flag.
